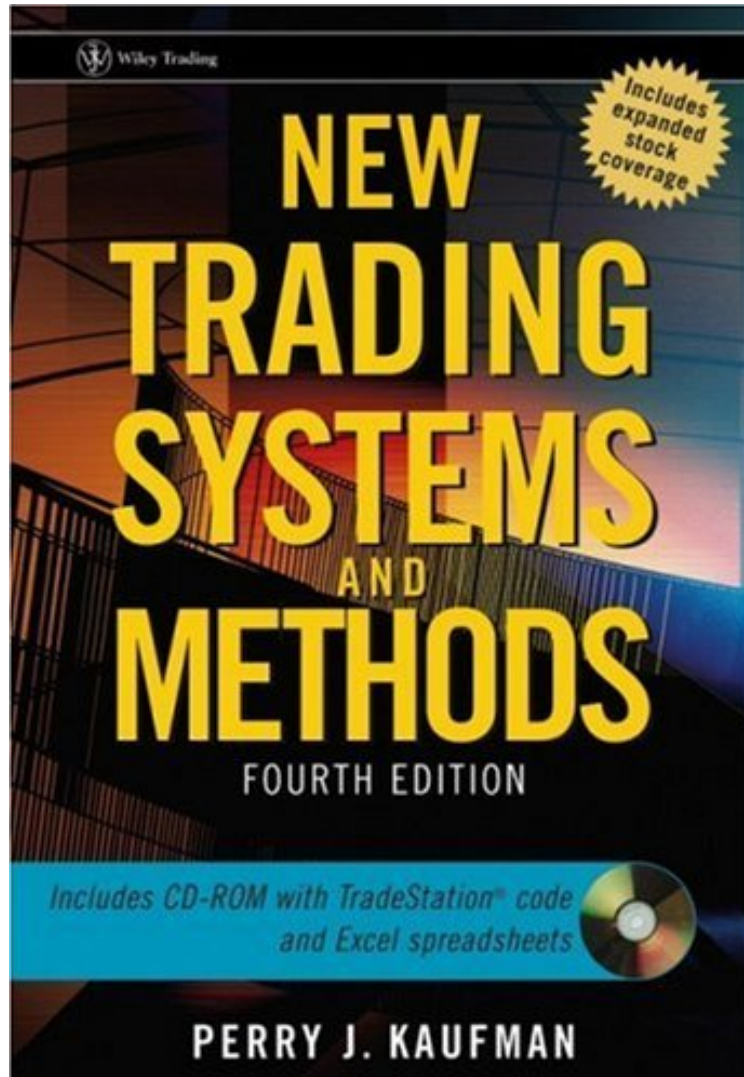

I use this as a reference book rather than a book to read cover to cover. The beginner may be overwhelmed with the quantity of material but well rewarded with such topics as Unexpected Price Shocks, which I have rarely seen covered. This book is extremely valuable for Tradestation users like me who aren't the best programmers. Trying something from the book couldn't be easier. The techniques import directly from the DVD into Tradestation. As a warning to readers not using

I got rid of all of my technical analysis books (aside from a few gems that covered material not in this book) and replaced them with this one. I think it's worth every penny. At the very least, it bought me some shelf space. In addition to the tech analysis, he covers the basics of developing and testing trading systems. I thought it was good coverage and that it laid a decent mathematical foundation for evaluation of systems. The reviewer that noted that there is nothing new in this book is correct; there isn't.
