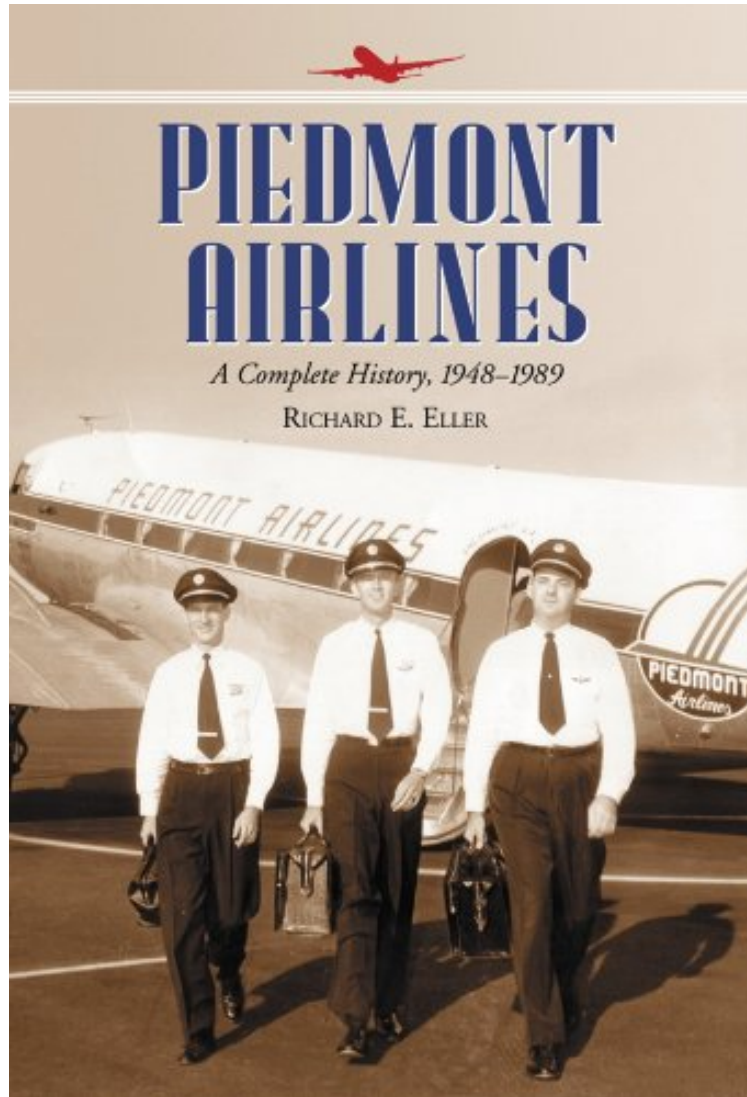

I credit those experiences with igniting my passion for aviation history. In "Piedmont Airlines: A Complete History", Mr. Eller goes back to before the beginning, decades before

Piedmont's first revenue flight to highlight all the people and events that came together in Winston-Salem to ultimately create something special, something we likely (and sadly) will never see again. The narrative captures the optimism of everyone involved, without ignoring or even sugarcoating the tragedies. This exhaustive history follows the airline from its humble beginnings at Smith Reynolds Airport in Winston-Salem, North Carolina, to its 1989 absorption into USAir after a buyout at the highest price ever commanded by a regional airline. Drawing upon corporate documents, local news stories, and countless personal interviews with former Piedmont employees, the author tells the airline's history in detail.
