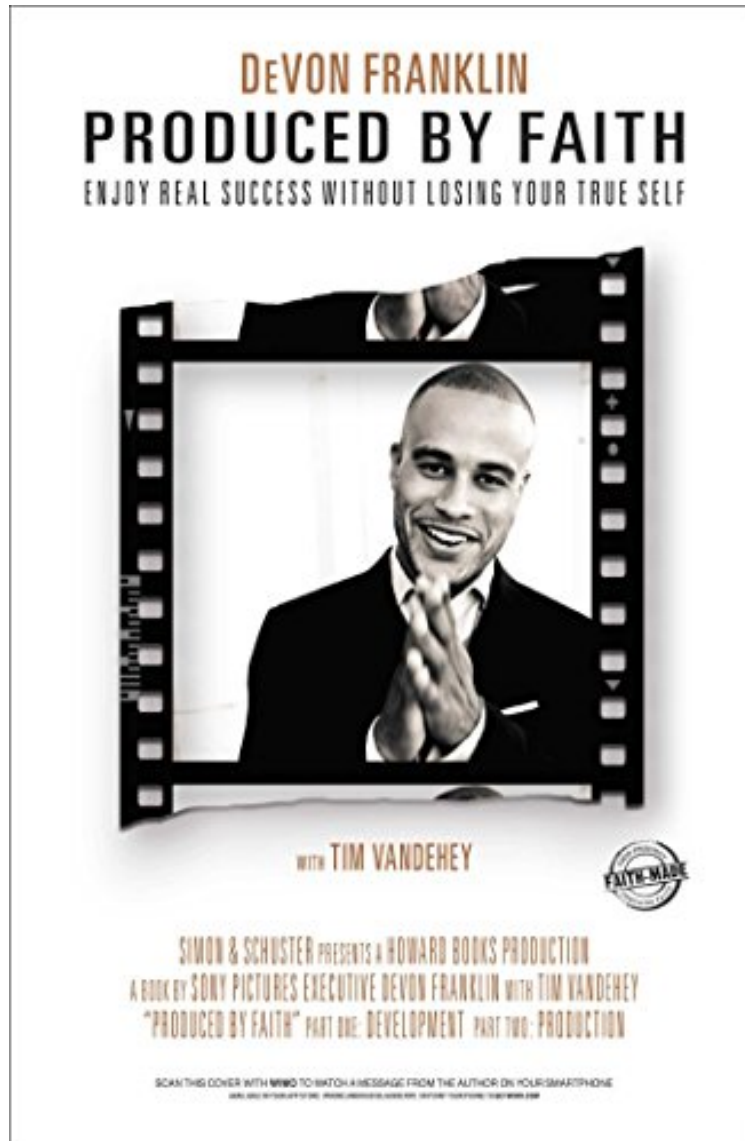

He does an awesome job with mixing three key elements: He talks about the movie industry (I've never learned so much about the industry till I read this book), he talks about his life lessons and experiences, and finally he gives you practical spiritual guidance. It's not always easy when dealing with a workplace or co-workers who often will berate anyone living a moral and religious lifestyle as being a "goody-two-shoes" when you decline offers to go out for drinks after work or to venues where our contemporary forms of social life and entertainment conflict with what scripture teaches about comporting ourselves, not in the manner that others would approve, but in the way that our faith in God directs us, without putting them on blast for their "alternate" lifestyles, use of profanity in common language and manners of attire that would prove embarrassing if we were to show up for church services dressed in similar fashion.
